

1 (1) by redesignating subsections (b) and (c) as
2 subsections (c) and (d), respectively; and

3 (2) in subsection (a), by striking “It shall” and
4 all that follows and inserting the following: “It shall
5 be unlawful for any person to manufacture or dis-
6 tribute a controlled substance in schedule I or II or
7 flunitrazepam or a listed chemical intending, know-
8 ing, or having reasonable cause to believe that such
9 substance or chemical will be unlawfully imported
10 into the United States or into waters within a dis-
11 tance of 12 miles of the coast of the United States.

12 “(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to manufac-
13 ture or distribute a listed chemical—

14 “(1) intending or knowing that the listed chem-
15 ical will be used to manufacture a controlled sub-
16 stance; and

17 “(2) intending, knowing, or having reasonable
18 cause to believe that the controlled substance will be
19 unlawfully imported into the United States.”.

20 **SEC. 3. TRAFFICKING IN COUNTERFEIT GOODS OR SERV-**
21 **ICES.**

22 Chapter 113 of title 18, United States Code, is
23 amended—

24 (1) in section 2318(b)(2), by striking “section
25 2320(e)” and insertion “section 2320(f)”; and

1 (2) in section 2320—

2 (A) in subsection (a), by striking para-
3 graph (4) and inserting the following:

4 “(4) traffics in a drug and knowingly uses a
5 counterfeit mark on or in connection with such
6 drug,”;

7 (B) in subsection (b)(3), in the matter pre-
8 ceding subparagraph (A), by striking “counter-
9 feit drug” and inserting “drug that uses a
10 counterfeit mark on or in connection with the
11 drug”; and

12 (C) in subsection (f), by striking para-
13 graph (6) and inserting the following:

14 “(6) the term ‘drug’ means a drug, as defined
15 in section 201 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cos-
16 metic Act (21 U.S.C. 321).”.
