**A BILL**

To amend title 18, United States Code, to make fraudulent dealings in firearms and ammunition unlawful, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stopping the Fraudu-  
5 lent Sales of Firearms Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FRAUDULENT DEALINGS IN FIREARMS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922(a) of title 18, United  
8 States Code, is amended—

1           (1) in paragraph (9), by striking the period and  
2           at the end and inserting “; and”; and

3           (2) by adding at the end the following:

4           “(10) for any person—

5                 “(A) to import, manufacture, or sell a fire-  
6                 arm or ammunition by means of false or fraud-  
7                 ulent pretenses, representations, or promises;  
8                 and

9                 “(B) to transmit or cause to be trans-  
10                mitted, by means of wire, radio, or television  
11                communication in interstate or foreign com-  
12                merce, any communication relating to the im-  
13                portation, manufacture, or sale described in  
14                subparagraph (A).”.

15           (b) PENALTY.—Section 924(a)(1)(B) of title 18,  
16           United States Code, is amended by inserting “(a)(10),”  
17           before “(f)”.
