

Request for testing supplies, medical equipment, and policy changes

Office of Governor Gavin Newsom | July 14, 2020

- **Ventilators** - 10,000 ventilators for 90 days
- **Testing supplies:**
 - Roche Cobas 6800/8800 test reagents for SARS-CoV-2 detection to support 30,000 tests per day
 - Roche extraction reagents to support MP96, Compact, and LC 2.0 to support 20,000 tests per day between the 3 machine types
 - Abbott ID Now - 50 machines to place in prisons/jails for symptomatic testing, 15,000 cartridges per day to support jail/prison testing over coming 6 months and Imperial County's 2 hospitals
 - Cepheid GeneXpert - 100 machines to place in Skilled Nursing Facilities for asymptomatic and symptomatic testing and Imperial County's El Centro Hospital and 480,000 cartridges to support Skilled Nursing Facility testing over coming 6 months
 - Qiagen RNA extraction reagents to support 15,000 tests per day
 - BD Max supplies to support Imperial Public Health Lab and an additional 200 boxes per week for California's allocation from BD
 - Biomerieux EasyMAG (new RNA extraction kits) - enough for 30,000 reactions per week.
 - Hologic Panther Fusions - 29 machines for Public Health Labs, reagents to support 29,000 tests per day, and Hologic TMA reagents to support 15,000
- **Veterans testing** – Authorize federal responsibility to test all CA Veterans for free at any VA Hospital
- **National Guard** - extend Title 32 authority for up to 1,500 California National Guard personnel through December 31, 2020 to continue our response to the COVID-19 public health emergency
- **FEMA policies** – increase the federal cost share for Public Assistance to 100%; implement the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the COVID-19 pandemic to address Medical facility surge capacity and retrofit, telecommunications infrastructure improvements, public health measures to safeguard critical infrastructure personnel and facilities
- **Prisons** – prioritize PPE and rapid testing at correctional facilities
