A BILL

To modify the authorized uses of certain property conveyed by the United States in Los Angeles, California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF AUTHORIZED USES OF CER-**
4 **TAIN PROPERTY CONVEYED BY THE UNITED**
5 **STATES IN LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2 of Public Law 85–236
7 (71 Stat. 517) is amended in the first sentence by insert-
8 ing after “for other military purposes,” the following: “for
9 purposes of meeting the needs of the homeless (as that

1 term is defined in section 103 of the McKinney-Vento
2 Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11302),”.

3 (b) MODIFICATION OF USE.—

4 (1) APPLICATION.—The State of California
5 shall submit to the Administrator of General Serv-
6 ices an application for use of the property conveyed
7 by section 2 of Public Law 85–236 for purposes of
8 meeting the needs of the homeless in accordance
9 with the amendment made by subsection (a).

10 (2) REVIEW OF APPLICATION.—Not later than
11 60 days after the date of receipt of an application
12 pursuant to paragraph (1), the Administrator and
13 the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall
14 jointly determine whether the use of the property de-
15 scribed in the application is a use for purposes of
16 meeting the needs of the homeless.

17 (3) MODIFICATION OF INSTRUMENT OF CON-
18 VEYANCE.—If the Administrator and the Secretary
19 jointly determine that the use of the property de-
20 scribed in the application is for purposes of meeting
21 the needs of the homeless, the Administrator shall
22 execute and record in the appropriate office an in-
23 strument of modification of the deed of conveyance
24 executed pursuant to Public Law 85–236 in order to
25 authorize such use of the property. The instrument

1 shall include such additional terms and conditions as
2 the Administrator considers appropriate to protect
3 the interests of the United States.
